- **Ms. Susanne Kippenberger**, editor of Berlin-based “Der Tagesspiegel“ (circulation: 130,000). The daily newspaper provides background information and analysis on politics, business, and culture, straight from the capital.
- **Ms. Sabine Loeprick**, freelance journalist for several media outlets like:
 - Rundfunk Berlin-Brandenburg (rbb) a public radio broadcaster for the German states Berlin and Brandenburg. More than 1.5 million people listen to the radio programs of rbb, which represents a market share of 30 %.
 - The weekly magazine "Forum Magazine" (circulation: 37,000) has a regional focus on the Berlin-Brandenburg area. Exclusive topics with relevance to the future are popular, as are stories from politics, business, society, sports, culture, technology, research, leisure, and lifestyle.
 - The monothematic and bimonthly USA travel magazine “AMERICA Journal” (circulation: 35,500) has been providing travel reports, background information, and current information useful for travel planning for 33 years: Emotional and authentic, with careful on-site research, professional presentation, and texts that are committed to journalistic standards.
- **Mr. Michael Juhran** is a freelance journalist with a strong focus on travel and tourism. His reports are published by numerous media, among others regularly by daily newspapers like:
 - “Rheinische Post” (circulation: 249,000)
 - “Neue Westfälische” (circulation: 190,000)
 - Michael is also writing regularly for the print magazine “360° Nordamerika” covering the destinations USA and Canada (published four times a year with 30,000 copies). It offers all-around reporting with a focus on travel as well as nature, culture, society, emigration, lifestyle, and current events (tailored to the respective destinations).
